# Summary of Sustainable Swaledale meeting held 9<sup>th</sup> January 2020

The following items were covered:

## Events

- Review of the 'Leyburn environmental fair' event held shortly before Christmas, which was useful for building contacts with other local environmental groups.
- Planning for future events, including the 'Breaking the sacred hoop' talk by Mike Sparrow scheduled for 23<sup>rd</sup> January and the 'Swaledale night sky' talk by Paul Clark on the 18<sup>th</sup> February.
- Some possible future events were also discussed, including further talks/films in the 'winter series', a spring litter pick event, and possible participation at the Reeth & Muker summer shows.

## **YDNPA** meeting

• There was a productive initial meeting with the YDNPA and local charity 'Friends of the Dales', which was valuable for understanding synergies and possible areas for future collaboration.

## Richmondshire District Council (RDC) climate emergency

• We continue to encourage RDC to take positive action following their declaration of a climate emergency in 2019. Latest report is that they are in the process of setting up a working group on climate change which will convene in January and report back to the members in March 2020.

### **Other initiatives**

- A proposal was made to set up an online 'recipe book' that highlighted climate-friendly vegan, vegetarian and meat-based eating options and promoted locally-sourced ingredients.
- We are awaiting confirmation of some funding for materials to build the 'Incredible Edible' veggrowing plot in Reeth, and will start work on converting the plot in time for the spring growing season.
